A particularly good way to do this is with the free mobile app Terra Aventura, which has already won over 700,000 French and English-speaking players.



Bordeaux Wine Routes in Graves & Sauternes

A journey into the origins of the Wines of Bordeaux on the Graves and Sauternes Bordeaux Wine Trails. It was in the Graves appellation that the first ever Bordeaux vines were planted over 2000 years ago.

The territory is remarkable by its diversity; there are the prestigious Château d'Yquem and Haut-Brion, as well as family-run estates, castles for families to enjoy, along with excellent Michelin-starred or lesser-known restaurants. Hospitality is at the heart of the Bordeaux Wine

Route in Graves and Sauternes.

Today, Bordeaux Wine Route in Graves and Sauternes includes 6 great appellations: Graves et Graves Supérieures, Pessac-Léognan, Barsac, Sauternes et Cérons. The name of this wine route comes from the region's gravelly, pebbly soil which is perfect for grape growing.

Bordeaux Wine Routes in Saint-Emilion, Pomerol, Fronsac

At the confluence of three rivers (the Dordogne, the Isle and the Dronne), the Libournais is an area where you can find UNESCO listed wine-producing areas, an old English fortified town (Libourne) and the largest monolithic church in Europe (Saint-Emilion): a real feast for any lovers of wine, cultural heritage and nature! Saint-Emilion is renowned for its wines as much as the village itself, dominating the Dordogne valley from its hilltop position. This vi-

neyard became the first vineyard in the world to be awarded the title of 'Cultural Landscape' by UNESCO on the World Heritage List in 1999 as a historical landscape that remains intact and continues as a working activity.

Nearby Pomerol is much smaller but shares its Roman history with that of St Emilion with the tiny appellation of Lalande de Pomerol at its northern tip. A stone's throw from Libourne, the principal town of the region, and the convergence of the rivers Dordogne and l'Isle, lies Fronsac with two main sectors: Fronsac and Canon Fronsac.

SPEND A NIGHT IN A BARREL

A few steps from the Château de Bonhoste in Saint-Jean de Blaignac, discover a unique and very unusual accomodation in the vineyard: the "Coup 2 foudres". The Fournier family is welcoming you in quite unusual guest rooms: wine vats that have been built by Seguin Moreau, a local well-known barrel maker. It's something that needs to be experienced, the place is very comfortable: 20m² with a bedroom, bathroom, kitchenette, sitting area and a private terrace with view



on the vines. A perfect way to forget the stresses and strains of daily life. From 140€/night

HIKE AND TAPAS IN THE VINEYARDS

Let's go for a stroll in the vines! The Château Boutinet is a family owned winery, in Fonsac soil: a green area nestled on a limestone hill. Go for a walk through the vines with Nathalie, the winegrower and owner of the château, who is also a professional guide. She is sharing her passion of vines and nature, explaining the vineyard works all along the year. Char-

ming landscapes: vines, meadow, ruins, forest... After an hour and a half wandering in the nature, her partner Jérôme, the winemaker, is offering a wine tasting under the oak trees. A very pleasant time, savouring homemade tapas, with friendliness and simplicity!

AN "ESCAPE WINE" AT CHÂ-**TEAU PAS DE L'ANE**

Your escape game mission: find the château's special vintage and its oenological secret! Rummage around and solve enigmas of logic and of the senses to find the code which reveals the "oenological" secret.

APPRENTICE WINEMAKERS AT CHÂTEAU CORMEIL FIGEAC

During 1h30, Coraline animates a workshop for children from 3 to 15 years to introduce them to the vine and vinification at Château Cormeil Figeac, a family wine estate located 5 minutes from the center of Saint-Emilion. To begin, each child takes a basket to harvest grapes, leaves, pebbles in the vineyards ... in order to recreate

a lively vine! Then, the youngest learn to taste grape juice like pros: observation, tasting and spitting! Finally, all children choose a bottle to label and seal it with the machine of the wine estate. During this time, parents can enjoy 2 wines from Château Cormeil-Figeac. 10€/children and 5€/ adult



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2019: 20 YEARS OF LISTING **AS UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE** SITES FOR THE JURISDICTION OF **SAINT-ÉMILION**

December 1999 remains an historic date for Saint-Émilion! It was on this date that the vineyard and the 8 villages of the Jurisdiction of Saint-Émilion were listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site for its «cultural landscape». A world first! Year 2019 will be dedicated to the celebration of these 20 years of registration on UNESCO list.

THE CHÂTEAU DE LA DAUPHINE **GREEN TOUR**

Thanks to this new natural tour, which has just won a Best of Wine Tourism gold award, you can explore the ethical and environmental actions that are being taken at Château de La Dauphine. Enjoy a fun experience, articulated around their organic methods, and a workshop on biodynamics; the Château adopted these practices 6 years ago to promote a greater respect for nature and mankind. Not to mention the bees and their hives! They play a major role in pollination, as well as

in permaculture in the vegetable patch and for aquaponics, sustainable and independent ecosystems. The tour ends with a vegetated cocoon in the middle of the park where a wine, honey and merlot jelly tasting takes place, with everything made onsite! Duration 1.5/2 hours. 15€/ per from 2 to 12 people. Book in advance from May to October. Château La Dauphine is open all year on booking.

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LOTS OF WAYS TO DISCOVER **SAINT-EMILION VINEYARDS**

A ride in Saint-Emilion vineyard? Choose your way! Exotic (and electric) tour in a Tuk-tuk or excursion at the nonchalant pace of the tourist train surrounded by the Premier Grand Crus Classés vineyards of Saint-Emilion. On a Harley-Davidson with a professional rider or in a sidecar with a vintage feel. In a hot air balloon, flying over the area or close to the vines and the nature, cycling on an electric bike, from

MAGICAL TIME AT CHÂTEAU DE LA **RIVIÈRE**

A superb stone fort, renovated by Viollet le Duc, the Château de la Rivière dominates the Dordogne valley and 65.5 hectares of vineyards. Its 8 hectares of underground cellars are an ideal setting for maturing the wines it produces. The château's grounds are open to all. The five Gîtes de France Bacchus 4 épis B&B rooms were awarded the gold "Best Of" award for wine tourism in 2007, in the "Accommodation" category. Ask for the "Visite Prestige", which finishes with a tasting of 3 wines in the underground wine cellars, which has a natural spring and is lit by candles (25€/per 10 people max.), or the escape-game in the underground quarries. It's magic! Open all year.

Bordeaux Wine Routes in Entre-deux-Mers

Locally known as very welcoming, lots of wineries from this region are family owned and run with generosity... Entre-Deux-Mers takes its name from its location - the region is nestled between the Garonne and the Dordogne rivers, and lies to the south and east of Bordeaux.

The region has a long wine producing history; the earliest vines were planted by the ancient Romans, 2000 years ago. Wine produced by the Benedictine monks in the middle ages, initially for religious purposes, established Entre deux Mers reputation; pilgrims on the route to Santiago de Compostela resting at the Abbey would be offered the sweet white wines produced by the monks. The remains of their 11c Abbey La Sauve Majeure have been declared a protected site by UNESCO.

Hit the bicycle path 'Voie Verte Roger Lapébie' to the Entre-Deux-Mers wine road History buffs will feel right at home here: bastide towns, Romanesque churches, fortified mills and ancient villages are dotted all over this rolling landscape dear to the heart of the writer François Mauriac and the artist Henri de Toulouse-Lautrec.

WINE TOUR IN A CADILLAC



the better adapted graft doors, optimising the implantation, an acquisition of new know-how in close collaboration between wine technicians and oenologists, an improved farming practices.



Jurançon

The Jurancon is situated in the Béarn, in the department of the Pyrénées-Atlantiques, between Biarritz Lourdes, just a few kilometres from the City of Pau.

The wine entered into history with Henri IV. Indeed, in 1553, this future King of France was baptised at the Chateau of Pau with a drop of Jurançon, beginning a royal tradition.

It is one of the few appellations subject to a late harvest, which sometimes occurs when the first snow has fallen. The appellation's festival takes

place from September to December. The typical aromas of the Jurançon wines offer peach, pear and white flowers, vanilla and honey. The colour is a gentle amber. The wines make the perfect accompaniment to foiegras and smoked salmon, but also to all the specialties of the South West region.

Here you won't find large chateaux to visit but Domaines, the people and small plots to be discovered, nestled in the bends of country lanes.

Nothing but slopes! From the Boule-

vard des Pyrénées in Pau, you have a great view of the Pyrenees - blue or white depending on the season. As the Jurançon wine area is further south than Pau, you really are in the foothills and the views are breathtaking: the Pic du Midi d'Ossau, a cirque planted with vines... Get your walking shoes on! There are a great many hiking circuits on offer, as well as outings on horseback or with snowshoes.

Entering the region from the north the red wines of Haut Poitou and the IGP vins de Loire, fragrant and fruity wines welcome you a few miles away from the châteaux of the Loire Valley.



Continuing towards the Corrèze you will be enveloped by the sweetness of the «straw» wine, the authenticity and rusticity of the reds and rosés of the Vézère hillside, produced on a centuries-old vine.



Further south, a cruise on the Garonne and Baïse is the ideal opportunity to discover the robust wines of the côte de Marmandais and Buzet, which perfectly match the local cuisine.

The arrival in the Landes forest brings us to the production area of Armagnac, a spirit blessed by the gods. In the evening a cool glass of Tursan will be appreciated after a day at the beach.



Near the Spanish border, the Béarn and the Basque Country make it possible to go on long and beautiful hikes in the Pyrenees and to regain your strength by tasting the cheeses of sheep and cows, the black pork meats of Bigorre accompanied by a pretty red from Irouléguy or Madiran.
