






### **COMING TO CHÂTEL**

Located in the heart of the Portes du Soleil between Lake Geneva and Mont-Blanc, Châtel is just 20 minutes from the Swiss motorways, 30 minutes from Aigle railway station, 1 1/4 hours from Geneva Cointrin international airport and 45 minutes from Thonon-les-Bains railway station.

### BY ROAD

**From France:** follow signs for Geneva, exit the autoroute at Annemasse, continue to Thonon then follow signs for Vallée d'Abondance/Châtel.

**From Switzerland:** follow signs for Monthey - Grand Saint Bernard, exit the autoroute at Monthey (Portes du Soleil exit) then follow signs for Morgins.

#### BY RAIL

**From France:** Thonon railway station is the closest to the resort. There is a bus service for transfer to the resort.

**From Switzerland:** there is a daily rail service between Geneva airport and Aigle. Transfers between the station and resort are by taxi.

During school holidays, the Buski service operates transfers between the Valley resorts and the TGV Lyria rail service at Aigle station.

### **NEW THIS WINTER**

Its opening, part of the on-going resort development plan, means that holidaymakers and residents can now use a fun leisure facility to fit around their skiing time or in conjunction with Châtel's other activities.

With different areas: indoor and outdoor pools, the Océane spa, a wet and dry zone, a seaweed therapy area to stimulate the senses with its Algotherm products, and an inventive and varied aqua-fitness programme (offering sessions with evocative names like Aquazen, Aquabalance, Aquafusion, Aquabuilding...), there's something for everyone!

There has always been a wide choice of relaxation and anti-stress options in Châtel:

- > La Fée du Bien-être and balenotherapy centre with Medy Jet water massage benches, amongst other things;
- A massage clinic (physiotherapy) offering Californian, sport, relaxation and circulatory massages in addition to teaching baby massage;
- > The Authentique Voyage spa at the Macchi hotel\*\*\*\*, the only Indian influenced spa in the mountains;
- > The Petales beautician with facial and body treatments;

In addition, many hotels, apartments and the camp site have covered swimming pools and/or offer health and beauty treatment services for the use of their clients — in some cases for over 20 years. This new water centre will also support accommodation providers by offering facilities for clients where they are not available on site.


Châtel now prides itself on providing an extensive range of aqua fun and health and beauty facilities to suit all tastes.



An important new improvement in the ski area this winter is the link between Super-Châtel and Linga. This connection can now be partly completed using 4-man and 6-man detachable chair lifts. The lifts will function in both directions this winter as the ski pistes that link them will not be operational until winter 2015-2016. Both lifts will leave from Vonnes, an area of Châtel located on the border towards Morgins, a neighbouring resort on the Swiss side of the Portes du Soleil.

This link will ease circulation in the ski area and reduce the use of the free bus service and private vehicles.

The Châtel ski area spans the two Super-Châtel mountains — Barbossine and Linga Pré-la-Joux — Plaine-Dranse, and the Châtel ski pass gives access to 56 ski lifts and 69 ski runs covering 130 km of pistes. It is also valid for the Swiss resort of Torgon, the Corbeau section of the Swiss resort of Morgins and the Braitaz sector of La Chapelle d'Abondance (including the Panthiaz cable car).

The resort has themed parts of the ski area – in particular Super-Châtel – with a variety of different equipment. There is the Mauve Milka run for children and adults with fun, informative details on alpine wildlife; an area where skiers can learn the importance of speed, how to control it and the effect it has on the gravity of accidents; the Smooth Park with modules for skiers of all levels where they can film their exploits on the "Live Park" video system and put them on the internet; the DVA Park by the Chanterelle piste where skiers learn how to use DVA, (Detecteur des Victimes en Avalanche) and test their own equipment.

In the Linga area every Thursday between 7.30pm and 9.30pm those wishing to extend their day on the slopes can ski the flood-lit slalom run, accompanied by music.


### **ACCOMMODATION**

In the last four years Châtel has acquired new accommodation: the 3-star and 4-star apartments; Le Grand Lodge\*\*\* and Le Grand Ermitage\*\*\*\* built by Vinci sold through Néméa; and Les Chalets d'Angèle\*\*\*\* built by MGM and sold by CGH. These developments, carefully designed to ensure wood and stone blend sympathetically with their surroundings, have been very successful.

In conjunction with this new construction, various existing hotels are undergoing renovation work to create individual apartments for sale on the open market. This is the case for the Bellevue and Les Soldanelles hotels, which will have 16 and 35 apartments respectively of between 2 and 5 rooms each.

During the latter half of 2015 further accommodation will become available. The "Fermes de Châtel" apartments, which have asked for 4\* classification, comprises 3 large chalets with a total of 90 apartments, a health and beauty centre and a leisure area with indoor swimming pool, located in the heart of the resort close to the bottom of the Super-Châtel cable car. Building work is being carried out by Quanim and Escrim and the apartments, of 2 to 4 rooms, will be marketed by Odalys.





"Les Loges Blanches", another new development will be constructed in the resort centre. There will be a total of 33 apartments in two buildings ranging in size from 2-4 rooms. This too should be completed by the end of 2016.

Over the last 4 years, various new independent chalets with average capacities of between 10 and 20 people, have also been constructed.

### 1 RESORT - 2 ACCREDITATIONS



As a "Pays d'Art et d'Histoire" (Art and History Region), promoting the quality of local architecture and heritage to visitors and inhabitants is a priority in the Abondance valley. The tourist attractions in the region centre around various important visitor sites and activities supervised by tour guides throughout the year. In Châtel the Old Customs House and Crépy Sawmill have, among other sites, been redeveloped.

# THE OLD CUSTOMS HOUSE OR MOUNTAIN SMUGGLING INFORMATION CENTRE

Since it opened, the Old Customs House, a mountain smuggling and contraband information centre, has proved very popular with visitors. It illustrates an important part of local history for the resort, the Abondance valley and the Portes du Soleil: Smuggling.

In fact descendants of the original participants in this exciting phase of local history, where customs officers and smugglers played a dangerous game of cat and mouse, are often among the visitors to the site.





Illustrations and artefacts from the time are displayed throughout the rooms and this year, to coincide with the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the First World War, there will be a temporary exhibition "From the Front to the Border: Savoyard customs officers in the First World War" which will look at the role of the French/Swiss border and the mobilisation of Savoyard customs officials. Visitors of all ages will enjoy learning about the Old Customs House and its role in history from the documents and exhibits on display.

#### THE CREPY SAWMILL

The Crepy Sawmill has been undergoing restoration to its original state over the last 3 years. The sawmill last operated in 1966 and is integral to the resort's history and heritage. It bears testament to the important role of forestry in this densely wooded mid-mountain region. Once cut, the wood was floated along the Dranse River to Lac Léman.

Forestry is still important today, but times and methods have evolved...

The restoration work is nearly complete and it is planned that this new visitor site will open soon. For now, it is still interesting to visit the exterior of the building.



grandparents and grandchildren can spend fun, quality time together - there is no shortage of activities to enjoy in Châtel!

There is ice-fishing for all levels, supervised by a qualified instructor at Vonnes Lake in a bucolic, snowy setting. This sport has been available for a number of years now and has proved very popular! For family walks try the Eterlou Trail – fun and interesting, it gives information on the local environment and mountain flora and fauna. It is a circular trail located at Pré-la-Joux next to the luge runs and has ten display panels to guide families and help answer various questions. The designated luge areas are perfect for sledging in total security - one is on the Nordic path at Sous Vonnes, accessible by foot from the village centre, and another at Super Châtel, accessed by the Super Châtel bubble lift – payment required – and then a 15 minute walk. Don't forget the Mauve Milka piste mentioned in the "Ski Area" section at the beginning of this document.



Châtel resort is a village that has existed forever and retained its identity as it developed. So it is no surprise that as one explores the village on foot or in the little train, one can spot the beautiful old farms with carved wooden balconies, so typical of the Abondance valley, some of which are over 100 years old. They are home to farmers and their families and herds of Abondance cattle. There are guided farm visits every week, when farmers open their doors to the public and let you into the secrets of making delicious local products like Abondance cheese (AOC) - and tasting it!

During school holidays additional activities are scheduled; giant wooden family games and other age-related children's activities such as foam pits, Lego, treasure hunts exploring the village...

There are wood-craft workshops and themed weeks to coincide with Christmas, Carnival and the Agricultural show - non-stop entertainment to delight the younger generation.

# **OUTDOOR ACTIVITIES**

There are a huge variety of outdoor activities available in Châtel: skiing, ice fishing, skating, curling or sledging on dedicated runs. We zoom in on hiking and paragliding.

#### **HIKING**

The resort is ideally located in a diverse mid-mountain landscape of forests and pastures. Although all kinds of ski sports are available, they are not the only options! **Hiking and accompanied snow shoe walking** are wonderful ways to appreciate unspoilt nature. Nearly 40 km of marked trails of all levels mean nature-lovers can find their own treasures: secret, less-visited corners of the area and amazing views! Meeting other walkers is always a pleasure, giving an opportunity to exchange pleasantries and recently discovered secrets. For these activities, a picnic is a great idea.



However, some trails lead to charming alpine chalet-restaurants used to serving hungry walkers. This is the case on the Petit-Châtel trail, which goes through the La Pierre hamlet before or after the Col du Saix (depending on which direction one is going). Here you will find le Chalet de Théo, a quiet location offering a wonderfully warm, friendly welcome. Norbert and Marie-Pierre's hospitality invariably leaves customers feeling like family and having enjoyed an unforgettable gastronomic experience!

One of the many trails crosses the border, and it is possible to start a hike in France from Super-Châtel, continue into Switzerland and return to Châtel at the end of a day or half-day. The variety of scenery is amazing and the views are incredible!



### NORDIC SKIING IN THE ABONDANCE VALLEY

Located on the banks of the Dranse River, close to Switzerland, the Nordic Skiing area covers three villages: Abondance, La Chapelle d'Abondance and Châtel.

There are nearly 40 km of ski runs and Nordic skiing trails between 900 m and 1500 m altitude. The Nordic reception area in La Chapelle d'Abondance is very dynamic, organising various Nordic activities (a biathlon between Abondance and Châtel, ski orienteering, sledging...) and different events during the season.

This winter's January Festi'Nordic event will now be held in 2016 to make way for two other big winter events (further information on page 14):



# A CONTROLLED ENVIRONMENT

Some years ago the resort signed the sustainable development charter. Concrete policies have already been implemented such as: the introduction of separate recycling bins which gets more and more effective each year with the development of moloks, tighter organisation at the public rubbish tip, low energy consumption public lighting, protection of mountain springs, more efficient engines for piste groomers, free minibuses, dustbins in the ski area and ashtrays at the start of ski lifts. There is also a noticeable move towards environmentally friendly building construction - comprehensively illustrated by the new Forme d'O aquatic centre.



In other areas countryside maintenance, including undergrowth clearance, natural soil conditioning and replanting are carried out in conjunction with local farmers who are, after all, nature's gardeners. In fact the quality of our countryside is reflected in the quality of our milk and local ski runs! During winter the lift operating company distributes bags to farmers so that in springtime, they can collect seeds left in their barns from the previous years's hay to spread on the pistes and retain the indigenous natural vegetation.

Not only that – the quality of the ski area is not simply due to great falls of snow, but equally to the excellent work carried out by the piste groomer drivers, which is appreciated by everyone, every year!

The ISO 9001 and 14001 certifications held by the lift pass company are the result of work meticulously carried out in order to maximize care for the environment through energy efficiency, water resource control, electric vehicles and end of season rubbish collection and recycling.

New certification, OHSAS 18001, an English abbreviation for "Occupational Health Safety Assessment Series" is planned for the personnel department of the company. Developed by the British Standards Institute this charter is internationally recognized and has the objective of ensuring rigorous and effective health and safety management in the workplace.

From an overall management perspective the OHSAS 18001 charter is totally compatible with the "Quality" ISO 9001 and "Environment" ISO 14001 charters. The implications are wide: security, strategic, economic, legal and managerial.

As you see: numerous projects have already been implemented. Others are planned.

Environmental management strategy is not something that will stand still!




